The activities will only be exempt if they meet the criteria set out in the relevant exemption paragraph at all times, and meet any additional requirements under regulation 17 of the 1994 regulations. The recovery of waste will only continue to be exempt if it does not endanger human health or involve processes which could harm the environment. In particular, it should not:

- pose a risk to water, air, soil, plants or animals
- cause nuisance through noise or odours
- adversely affect the countryside or places of special interest
